Wednesday September 4th, 8:55-3:00

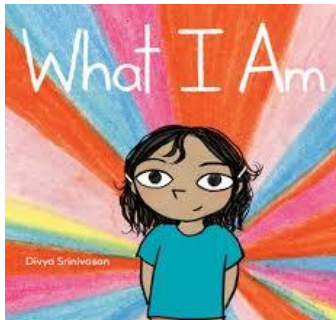
Return to previous classroom for attendance and then students placed in groups for the week (grades 1-3 and grade 4-7). Rotations to different teachers.
