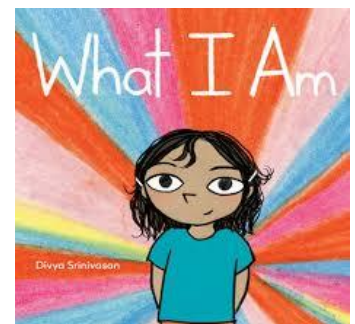
September at Clinton – What Do We Expect

- 1 Standard View Binder with D-Rings – ½" – White – Staples Item #1056705, Model #22128
- 1 box of Kleenex tissue

- 1 pair of inside shoes that your child can put on independently (to keep at school)
- Change of clothes (underwear, pants, top, socks & shoes) in a Ziploc bag marked clearly with your child's name
- In September, please pay \$35 in School Cash Online (<https://burnaby.schoolcashionline.com/>) for additional supplies fee – Teachers will use \$30 to purchase supplies as necessary throughout the year and \$5 for cooking and ADST learning experiences.
