5. Principal Report

- a. Currently we have 402 students, its a time of high volume, usually the school number is below 400.
 - i. Currently 4-5 new students per month likely due to rolling working visa approvals
 - ii. There has been student increases throughout the district
- b. Students in grade 4, 7 will be sent a Student Learning Survey
 - i. These are meant to survey areas for school improvement, also for areas that our school is doing well
 - ii. other grade parents can also participate in the survey on the school website
- A new Literacy Prevent program is funded by a new grant
 - i. focus is for K and 1st grade students
 - ii. goal is to target diverse learning, early intervention
 - iii. teachers will create assessments for students to highlight areas that need help
 - iv. if successful, may extend to grades 2nd and 3rd.
- d. ELL assessments are moving toward to being conducted at local schools
 - i. previously all incoming students with non-english mother language are sent to Malbourgh school for assessment
 - ii. now each school will train staff to conduct ELL assessment for incoming students
 - iii. will be implemented this upcoming 2025 september intake
 - 1. likely during first two weeks of school in september
- e. Kindergarten registration for 2025 has started
 - i. currently 37 students registered at Clinton, less than usual but its only beginning of February
 - ii. district predicting about 1200 new students upcoming year
 - iii. after february registration, school will start to prepare classes for next year
- f. Email to be sent home about walking through the parking lots
 - i. Near accident of child being hit by cars during morning time
 - ii. walking signs will be updated on correct pathways to be used
 - iii. teachers will also be reminding children during class
- g. Upcoming important dates
 - i. 2/25 lacrosse Vancouver Warriors team visiting- group assembly
 - ii. 2/26- Pink shirt day- also have assembly
 - iii. 2/27- Grade 7 public speech contest
 - 1. students of all grades will be learning with some public speaking topics and practice
 - iv. 3/3-14- Spring activity will be Tennis
 - 1. Fees are offset by PAC, there will be a small fee for parents
